2023 Nebraska Hereford Bull Hall of Fame

He was perhaps the most legendary Hereford sire in Northwest Nebraska during the 20th century. He was purchased from the TO Ranch in Raton, N. M. by V. C. Kennedy of Harrison and the Buffington Hereford Ranch of Crawford for \$38,000 soon after the Great Depression.

Notably, he never ran with a set of cows in a pasture...rather the cows were brought to him individually to allow his service on the largest possible number of females. His offspring were so popular that owners of his calves pooled his progeny in joint consignment sales.

Upon his death, the bull was buried near the barn of the Kennedy Ranch in a piano box.
